SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Correctional Services

17 9-612.
(A) IN THIS SECTION, "SEXUALLY EXPLICIT MATERIAL" MEANS AN AUDIOTAPE, FILM, VIDEOTAPE, PHOTOGRAPH, OR OTHER AUDIO OR VISUAL REPRESENTATION, PRODUCED IN ANY MEDIUM, THE DOMINANT THEME OF WHICH DEPICTS OR DESCRIBES NUDITY, INCLUDING SEXUAL OR EXCRETORY ACTIVITIES OR ORGANS, IN A LASCIVIOUS WAY.
(B) THE MANAGING OFFICIAL OF A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL 24 FACILITY MAY PROHIBIT THE SALE, RENTAL, AND DISTRIBUTION OF SEXUALLY 25 EXPLICIT MATERIAL IN THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
