A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - School Renovation - State Payments**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to pay certain percentages of the maximum
4 State construction allocation of the contract costs for renovating, modernizing,
5 altering, or remodeling, in whole or in part, existing school buildings that have
6 been occupied for certain amounts of time; and generally relating to State
7 payments for school renovation.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 5-303.1.

17 (A) THE STATE SHALL PAY THE CONTRACT COSTS FOR RENOVATING,
18 MODERNIZING, ALTERING, OR REMODELING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, AN EXISTING
19 SCHOOL BUILDING THAT HAS BEEN OCCUPIED FOR:

20 (1) 16 TO 25 YEARS, IN AN AMOUNT OF 50 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM
21 STATE CONSTRUCTION ALLOCATION OF THE CONTRACT COSTS;

22 (2) 26 TO 40 YEARS, IN AN AMOUNT OF 75 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM
23 STATE CONSTRUCTION ALLOCATION OF THE CONTRACT COSTS; AND

24 (3) 41 YEARS OR MORE, IN AN AMOUNT OF 100 PERCENT OF THE
25 MAXIMUM STATE CONSTRUCTION ALLOCATION OF THE CONTRACT COSTS.

1 (B) THE STATE MAY NOT PAY ANY OF THE CONTRACT COSTS FOR
2 RENOVATING, MODERNIZING, ALTERING, OR REMODELING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART,
3 AN EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDING THAT HAS BEEN OCCUPIED FOR 15 YEARS OR LESS.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 1999.
