2 Alcoholic Beverages - Delivery to University or College Campus

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain licensees from delivering alcoholic beverages
- 4 to certain buildings located at a university or college campus; providing for
- 5 certain exceptions; and generally relating to the delivery of alcoholic beverages
- 6 to a college or university campus.

- 8 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages

- 11 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 15 12-107.
- 16 (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN
- 17 OFF-SALE RETAIL LICENSEE MAY NOT DELIVER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY
- 18 KIND TO A DORMITORY, RESIDENCE HALL, FRATERNITY OR SORORITY HOUSE, OR
- 19 ANY OTHER RESIDENCE LOCATED AT A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE CAMPUS THAT THE
- 20 SELLER SHOULD REASONABLY BELIEVE TO BE ACCESSIBLE TO A PERSON UNDER 21
- 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- 22 (2) AN OFF-SALE RETAIL LICENSEE MAY DELIVER ALCOHOLIC
- 23 BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND TO A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE FACULTY
- 24 OR ADMINISTRATION WHO IS A CAMPUS RESIDENT.
- 25 (3) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION PROHIBITS:
- 26 (I) A CATERER OR SPECIAL LICENSEE FROM EXERCISING THE
- 27 PRIVILEGES OF ITS LICENSE; OR

- 1 (II) ANY OTHER LICENSEE FROM DELIVERING ALCOHOLIC
- 2 BEVERAGES TO ANY OFFICIALLY SPONSORED UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE FUNCTION
- 3 IN ANY BUILDING LOCATED AT THE UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE CAMPUS.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1999.
