BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 18 **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments** 19 555C. In this section, "electronic mail" means the transmission of information or 20 21 a communication by the use of a computer or other electronic means sent to a person 22 identified by a unique address and received by that person.
