- 3 (B) THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE GOVERNING
- 4 BODY OF A COUNTY OR OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE, BY LAW, FOR:
- 5 (1) THE AMOUNT AND DURATION OF THE TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS

- 7 (2) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE CREDIT
- 8 <u>UNDER THIS SECTION.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
