BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Labor and Employment** 15 9-101. "Accidental personal injury" means: 16 (b) 17 an accidental injury that arises out of and in the course of (1) 18 employment, INCLUDING AN ACCIDENTAL INJURY RESULTING FROM THE 19 PERFORMANCE OF ORDINARY, REGULAR, OR USUAL EMPLOYMENT-RELATED 20 ACTIVITIES OR RESPONSIBILITIES; an injury caused by a willful or negligent act of a third person 21 22 directed against a covered employee in the course of the employment of the covered 23 employee; or 24 a disease or infection that naturally results from an accidental injury 25 that arises out of and in the course of employment, including:
