BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 16 9-124. 17 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A PHYSICIAN MAY NOT BE 18 QUALIFIED AS AN EXPERT WITNESS TO TESTIFY ABOUT THE STANDARD OF CARE 19 APPLICABLE TO THE PRACTICE OF A MEDICAL SPECIALTY UNLESS THE WITNESS: 20 (1) IS A PHYSICIAN: PRACTICING IN THE SAME MEDICAL SPECIALTY AND 21 (I) 22 SUB-SPECIALTY AS THE DEFENDANT; OR WHO PRACTICED WITHIN THE PAST 2 YEARS IN THE SAME 23 (II)24 MEDICAL SPECIALTY AND SUB-SPECIALTY AS THE DEFENDANT PRIOR TO 25 RETIREMENT; IS BOARD CERTIFIED IN THE SAME MEDICAL SPECIALTY AT ISSUE IN (2)

- 1 HAS DEMONSTRATED CLINICAL EXPERIENCE IN THE SAME (3) 2 PROCEDURE AT ISSUE IN THE CASE.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 1999.
