A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Property Tax Credit - Beltsville/Adelphi Boys and**
3 **Girls Club**
4 **PG 406-99**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to
6 grant, by law, a credit against the county or special district property tax imposed
7 on property owned by the Beltsville/Adelphi Boys and Girls Club.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article - Tax - Property
10 Section 9-318(c)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Tax - Property**

16 9-318.

17 (c) The governing body of Prince George's County may grant, by law, a
18 property tax credit under this section against the county property tax or special
19 district tax imposed on:

20 (1) property that is owned by the Chapel Hill Citizens' Association;

21 (2) property that is:

22 (i) owned by the Clinton Boys and Girls Club; and

23 (ii) used only for nonprofit athletic recreation;

24 (3) property that is owned by the East Pines Citizens' Association;

- 1 (4) property that is owned by the Lions Club of Bowie;
- 2 (5) property that is owned by the Prince George's Jaycees, Incorporated;
- 3 (6) property that is owned by the Suitland Civic Association,
4 Incorporated;
- 5 (7) real property that is:
- 6 (i) owned by the Prince George's County Parks and Recreation
7 Foundation; and
- 8 (ii) is not used for a commercial purpose; [and]
- 9 (8) property that is:
- 10 (i) owned by the Freestate Riding Club, Inc.; and
- 11 (ii) used only for nonprofit athletic recreation[.]; AND
- 12 (9) PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE BELTSVILLE/ADELPHI BOYS AND
13 GIRLS CLUB.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 1999.
