A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Board of License Commissioners - Salaries**
3 **PG 304-99**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual salaries of the chairman, administrator,
5 attorney, and inspectors of the Board of License Commissioners for Prince
6 George's County; and generally relating to the salaries of certain officials of the
7 Board of License Commissioners for Prince George's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
10 Section 15-109(r) and 15-112(r)(3)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 15-109.

17 (r) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

18 (2) (i) Each of the members of the Board shall receive an annual
19 salary of [~~\$17,000~~] \$18,530.

20 (ii) The chairman shall receive an annual salary of [~~\$18,000~~]
21 \$19,620.

22 (3) The Board shall meet at least two times per month.

23 (4) (i) The administrator of the Board shall be appointed by and serve
24 at the will of the Board and shall devote full time and attention to the duties of the
25 Board.

1 (ii) The administrator may receive an annual salary of [\$40,705]
2 \$44,369 as determined by the Board of License Commissioners after a performance
3 evaluation.

4 (5) (i) The attorney for the Board shall be appointed by, and serve at
5 the will of, the Board.

6 (ii) The attorney shall receive an annual salary of [\$15,500] \$16,895
7 and the County Council shall pay all court costs and expenses incurred therein by the
8 attorney to the Board.

9 (6) The County Council shall pay for all expenses of the Board of License
10 Commissioners upon the submission of an annual budget. In that budget, the salary
11 of the members of the Board shall be approved as hereinbefore set forth; all other
12 expenses, including, but not restricted to, the compensation of the inspectors, the
13 salary of the administrator as limited herein, compensation of other personnel, who
14 shall be qualified and employed under the county merit system, printing, supplies,
15 and office space, shall be at the discretion of the County Council.

16 (7) (i) Members of the Board of Alcoholic Beverages License
17 Commissioners are eligible for:

- 18 1. All County health benefits; and
19 2. Membership in and retirement benefits of the State
20 Employees' Pension System.

21 (ii) The health benefits under this paragraph include:

- 22 1. Hospitalization;
23 2. Vision care;
24 3. Prescriptions;
25 4. Dental care;
26 5. Life insurance; and
27 6. Expense reimbursement.

28 (iii) The administrator of the Board of License Commissioners is
29 eligible to participate in the County's supplemental retirement plan.

30 (iv) The County Executive and County Council may not adopt,
31 either through public local law or personnel law, any policy contrary to the provisions
32 of subparagraph (i) or (iii) of this paragraph.

34 (r) (3) (i) The inspectors shall:
