A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - Shalom Community Initiative

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$450,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Shalom Community
- 5 Initiative for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for
- 6 disbursement of the loan proceeds; prohibiting the use of the proceeds for
- 7 sectarian religious purposes; and providing generally for the issuance and sale
- 8 of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 MARYLAND, That:
- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 13 City Shalom Community Initiative Loan of 1999 in the total principal amount of
- 14 \$450,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 15 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 16 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 17 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 25 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 23 Board of Fublic Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 26 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Shalom Community Initiative for the 27 planning, design, renovation, repair, reconstruction, and capital equipping of two
- 28 buildings on North Linwood Avenue in Baltimore, the first building to serve as a site
- 29 for Head Start, a senior center, and community association center, the second building
- 30 to serve as a site for the Youth Check Program, a psychosocial model that provides

- 1 highly technical assistance for adolescents who have been adjudicated as Children in 2 Need of Assistance (CINA).
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 (5) No portion of the proceeds of the loan may be used for the furtherance of
- 8 sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the design, acquisition, or
- 9 construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious
- 10 worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of divinity
- 11 for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board of Public Works, the
- 12 grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none of the proceeds of
- 13 the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a purpose prohibited
- 14 by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 June 1, 1999.
