- ON THE FILING OF ANY APPLICATION FOR ANY LICENSE REQUIRED 30 (A) (1)

- 32 COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION SHALL CONDUCT A BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

- 4 APPLICANT WHOM THE COMMISSION DETERMINES TO BE NOT QUALIFIED.
