- 2 (A) In order to encourage the preservation of natural resources and to
- 3 facilitate orderly growth and development in the State, the legislative body of a
- 4 county or municipal corporation, including Baltimore City, that exercises authority
- 5 granted by this article [may] SHALL establish a program for the transfer of
- 6 development rights.
- 7 (B) TO FACILITATE EFFORTS UNDER TITLE 5, SUBTITLE 7B OF THE STATE
- 8 FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE (GROWTH-RELATED PROJECTS AND
- 9 PRIORITY FUNDING AREAS), A PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
- 10 INCLUDE THE AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSFER DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS FROM A
- 11 COMMERCIAL USE TO ANOTHER COMMERCIAL USE OR OTHER MORE INTENSE USE.
