18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

22 (A) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH A HOME OFFICE EQUIPMENT 23 PURCHASE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.

24 (2) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENT FOR INTEREST
25 CHARGES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF HOME OFFICE
26 EQUIPMENT TO EMPLOYEES WHO:

27 (I) PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT PROGRAM;

	5 (B) AN EMPLOYEE MAY BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THE 6 PROGRAM FOR INTEREST CHARGES NOT EXCEEDING AN ACTUAL ANNUAL

7 PERCENTAGE RATE OF 10%.

8 (C) THE SECRETARY BY REGULATION SHALL ESTABLISH:

9 (1) CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR REIMBURSEMENT;

10 AND

11 (2) PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING FOR REIMBURSEMENT.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

13 October 1, 1999. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination

14 provisions of Chapter 529 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998. If that15 termination provisions takes effect, this Act shall be void.
