- 1 (2) When issued and signed, a driver's license authorizes the licensee to 2 drive any vehicle of the type or class specified on it, subject to any restrictions 3 endorsed on the license.
- 4 (f) (1) Only one current driver's license may be issued by the
- 5 Administration to and held by any individual at any one time.
- 6 (2) Before issuing a license, the Administration shall require the 7 applicant to surrender any other license issued to the applicant by any jurisdiction.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 9 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 10 on or application to any identification cards or driver's licenses printed before the
- 11 effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 July 1, 1999.
