4 FOR the purpose of establishing that a final judgment in an action for personal injury
5 protection coverage under a motor vehicle liability insurance policy does not
6 preclude certain subsequent actions from the same motor vehicle accident or
7 occurrence.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Insurance**

16 19-509.1.

17 A FINAL JUDGMENT IN AN ACTION FOR PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION
18 COVERAGE UNDER A MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY DOES NOT
19 PRECLUDE A SUBSEQUENT ACTION FOR UNINSURED OR UNDERINSURED MOTORIST
20 COVERAGE ARISING OUT OF THE SAME MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT OR
21 OCCURRENCE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1999.
