CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election - Compensation of Election Judges - Baltimore County**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the compensation of election judges in Baltimore

4 County by a certain amount; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary

5 or compensation of the incumbent election judges in Baltimore County; and

6 generally relating to the compensation of election judges.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

8 Article 33 - Election Code

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 33 - Election Code**

15 10-205.

16 (b) (3) In Baltimore County, the compensation for each election day actually
17 served shall be:

18 (i) [\$135] \$160 per day for each chief election judge; and

19 (ii) [\$100] \$125 per day for every other election judge.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
2 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
3 apply to the salary or compensation of the Baltimore County Election Judges in office
4 on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
5 compensation of the Baltimore County Election Judges shall take effect at the
6 beginning of the next following term of office.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 July 1, 1999.
