16 (1) A certificate of need is not required to close any hospital or part of a 17 hospital as defined in § 19-301 of this title if:

(1) At least 45 days before closing, written notice of intent to close, THAT
INCLUDES A PLAN ACCEPTED BY THE WORKERS OF THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY TO
SATISFY ALL STATE AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR DISPLACED WORKERS, is
filed with the Commission;

24 developed by the Commission and is in the public interest; and

25 (3) Within 45 days of receiving notice the Commission notifies the health 26 care facility of its findings.
