A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Driving in the Left Lane - Restrictions

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that on a roadway that has two or more lanes for traffic
- 4 moving in the same direction a vehicle may not be driven in the far left lane
- 5 unless the vehicle is overtaking another vehicle; and generally relating to
- 6 driving on divided roadways.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Transportation
- 15 21-309.
- 16 (a) On any roadway that is divided into two or more clearly marked lanes for
- 17 vehicular traffic, the following rules, in addition to any others consistent with them,
- 18 apply.
- 19 (b) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single
- 20 lane and may not be moved from that lane or moved from a shoulder or bikeway into
- 21 a lane until the driver has determined that it is safe to do so.
- 22 (c) On a roadway that is divided into three lanes and that provides for
- 23 two-way movement of traffic, a vehicle may not be driven in the center lane except:
- 24 (1) While overtaking and passing another vehicle going in the same
- 25 direction and while the center lane is clear of traffic within a safe distance;
- 26 (2) In preparing to make a left turn; or

- 1 (3) When the center lane is allocated exclusively to traffic moving in the
- 2 same direction that the vehicle is going and the allocation is designated by a traffic
- 3 control device.
- 4 (d) The driver of a vehicle shall obey the directions of each traffic control
- 5 device that directs specified traffic to use a designated lane or that designates those
- 6 lanes to be used by traffic moving in a particular direction, regardless of the center of
- 7 the roadway.
- 8 (e) The driver of a vehicle shall obey the directions of each traffic control
- 9 device that prohibits changing lanes on sections of a roadway.
- 10 (f) On a roadway that has two or more lanes for traffic moving in the same
- 11 direction, the driver of any truck, truck tractor, trailer, or bus shall obey the directions
- 12 of each traffic control device that requires the vehicle to be driven in a certain lane.
- 13 (g) On a roadway along which a two-way left turn lane has been provided
- 14 through traffic control devices, vehicles may not enter that lane except when
- 15 preparing for or making a left turn from or into the roadway or when preparing for or
- 16 making a U-turn, and may enter only if the lane is clear of an opposing movement.
- 17 (h) A vehicle shall be driven within a lane described under subsection (g) of
- 18 this section the shortest distance practicable prior to making a left turn or U-turn or
- 19 after making a left turn.
- 20 (i) On roadways along which a two-way left turn lane has been placed, left
- 21 turns shall be made only from within such lane.
- 22 (J) ON A ROADWAY THAT HAS TWO OR MORE LANES FOR TRAFFIC MOVING IN
- 23 THE SAME DIRECTION A VEHICLE MAY NOT BE DRIVEN IN THE FAR LEFT LANE
- 24 UNLESS THE VEHICLE IS OVERTAKING ANOTHER VEHICLE AS PROVIDED IN § 21-303
- 25 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1999.
