CHAPTER
1 AN ACT concerning
2 Creation of a State Debt - Women in Military Service for America Memorial Foundation, Inc.
4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$30,000, the 5 proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Women in Military 6 Service for America Memorial Foundation, Inc. for certain acquisition, 7 development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan 8 proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a 9 matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds 10 evidencing the loan.
11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That:
13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Women in 15 Military Service for America Memorial Foundation, Inc. Loan of 1999 in a total 16 principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$30,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching 17 fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by 18 the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a 19 resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance 20 with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and 21 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

- 1 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer 2 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and 3 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then 4 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the 5 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable 6 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Women in 7 Military Service for America Memorial Foundation, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this 8 Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, and construction of, and the provision of capital equipment for, the Women's Memorial at Arlington National Cemetery, a 10 memorial that will honor all the women who, throughout its history, were in the 11 military service in the United States.
- 12 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 13 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 14 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 15 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 16 Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 18 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either 19 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 20 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind 21 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any 22 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify 23 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the 24 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2001, to present evidence 25 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If 26 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of 27 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the 28 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. 29 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the 30 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 June 1, 1999.
