- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 IN ANY SUIT, ACTION, OR PROCEEDING BY A LANDLORD, OR THE TRANSFEREE
- 18 OF THE REVERSION IN LEASED PROPERTY, TO RECOVER BACK RENT, THE LANDLORD,
- 19 OR THE TRANSFEREE OF THE REVERSION IN LEASED PROPERTY:
- 20 (1) IS ENTITLED TO DEMAND OR RECOVER NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS
- 21 BACK RENT; AND
- 22 (2) UNLESS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN THE LEASE OR ORDERED BY A
- 23 COURT, IS NOT ENTITLED TO RECOVER ATTORNEY'S FEES FROM THE TENANT OR
- 24 ASSIGNEE OF A LEASE.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 26 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 27 on or application to any suit, action, or proceeding for back rent before the effective
- 28 date of this Act.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1999.
