1 THIS SUBTITLE WHICH MUST BE FILED WITH THE STATE BOARD MAY BE SUBMITTED 2 USING ANY ELECTRONIC MEDIUM APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD. 3 Beginning in November 1999, upon request, the State Board shall 4 supply to a person who is required to file reports [in an electronic storage format] 5 USING AN ELECTRONIC MEDIUM the computer software and the disks or other media 6 on which the campaign finance information is to be entered. Beginning in November 1999, the State Board shall make the 7 8 campaign finance information that is filed with and maintained by the State Board in 9 an electronic storage format widely and easily accessible to the public, utilizing any 10 existing public or private systems for data dissemination, and on terms that the State Board considers consistent with the purposes and requirements of this article. 12 (e) The State Board may: 13 (1) Refuse to accept or process any campaign finance report that is 14 incomplete or not submitted in accordance with the requirements of this section; and 15 Exempt candidates, personal treasurer accounts, and political 16 committees with de minimis financial activity from submitting campaign finance 17 reports [in an electronic storage format] USING AN ELECTRONIC MEDIUM. 18 (f) The State Board shall: 19 (1) Develop specifications for [the submission of] SUBMITTING 20 campaign finance reports [in an electronic storage format] USING AN ELECTRONIC 21 MEDIUM: and 22 (2) Adopt regulations necessary to implement the requirements of this 23 section. 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
