## University of Maryland, Maryland Cooperative Extension - Dairy Farm Nutrient and Business Management Program

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Dairy Farm Nutrient and Business Management

- 5 Program administered by the University of Maryland, Maryland Cooperative
- 6 Extension; requiring the Program to develop and maintain a certain Dairy
- 7 Nutrient and Business Management Team to plan certain meetings and
- 8 workshops for State dairy farmers, their families, and their employees on
- 9 certain topics; mandating that the Program develop and maintain a certain
- 10 Dairy Advisory Team Program to organize certain local advisory teams to advise
- 11 and assist certain dairy farmers on certain matters; authorizing the Department
