A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Garrett County - Liquor Control Board - Meetings**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the chairman of the Liquor Control Board of Garrett  
4 County to cancel a board meeting because of a lack of an agenda; and generally  
5 relating to the Liquor Control Board of Garrett County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 15-201(i)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 15-201.

15 (i) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Board shall meet  
16 as frequently as in their respective opinions may be necessary for the public business.

17 (2) In Worcester County they shall meet at least once each week; in  
18 Somerset County they shall meet at least twice each month.

19 (3) In Harford County they shall meet at least fifty times each year, but  
20 the chairman may cancel any of those meetings for lack of an agenda.

21 (4) In Montgomery County, the director of the Department of Liquor  
22 Control shall devote all his time to the duties of his office.

23 (5) In Garrett County the Board shall meet at least once each month,  
24 BUT THE CHAIRMAN MAY CANCEL A MEETING FOR LACK OF AN AGENDA.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 October 1, 1999.
