- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 14 15-201.
- 15 (i) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Board shall meet 16 as frequently as in their respective opinions may be necessary for the public business.
- 17 (2) In Worcester County they shall meet at least once each week; in
- 18 Somerset County they shall meet at least twice each month.
- 19 (3) In Harford County they shall meet at least fifty times each year, but 20 the chairman may cancel any of those meetings for lack of an agenda.
- 21 (4) In Montgomery County, the director of the Department of Liquor
- 22 Control shall devote all his time to the duties of his office.
- 23 (5) In Garrett County the Board shall meet at least once each month,
- 24 BUT THE CHAIRMAN MAY CANCEL A MEETING FOR LACK OF AN AGENDA.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 1999.
