11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
14 15-201.
15 (i) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Board shall meet 16 as frequently as in their respective opinions may be necessary for the public business.
17 (2) In Worcester County they shall meet at least once each week; in 18 Somerset County they shall meet at least twice each month.
19 (3) In Harford County they shall meet at least fifty times each year, but 20 the chairman may cancel any of those meetings for lack of an agenda.
