FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Wicomico County to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county property tax imposed on certain land; requiring the governing body of Wicomico County to address certain issues regarding any property tax credit established; and generally relating to a property tax credit for agricultural land in Wicomico County. BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Tax - Property Section 9-324 Annotated Code of Maryland (1994 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
