1 AN ACT concerning

2                                   **Legal Officials - Anne Arundel County Assistant State's Attorneys - Sharing**  
3                                   **Full-Time Position**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Anne Arundel County State's Attorney to  
5 designate two or more assistant State's Attorneys to share one or more full time  
6 positions; and generally relating to the authority of the Anne Arundel County  
7 State's Attorney to designate the sharing of a full-time assistant State's  
8 Attorney position.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article 10 - Legal Officials  
11 Section 40(c)(5)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16                                   **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

18 (c) In Anne Arundel County:

19 (5) (I) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,  
20 THE deputy State's Attorneys and the assistant State's Attorneys shall be precluded  
21 from the private practice of criminal law and, with the exception of one assistant,  
22 shall serve full time.

23 (II) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY CODE,  
24 THE STATE'S ATTORNEY MAY DESIGNATE TWO OR MORE ASSISTANT STATE'S  
25 ATTORNEYS TO SHARE ONE OR MORE FULL-TIME POSITIONS.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 1999.
