4 FOR the purpose of increasing the membership of the State Employees' Health

6 Health Insurance Advisory Council.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

15 2-505.

16 (b) The Advisory Council consists of the following [15] 18 members:

17 (1) the Secretary or a designee of the Secretary;

18 (2) a representative of each of the following, appointed by the Governor:

- 1 (i) the Department of Budget and Management;
- 2 (ii) the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- 3 (iii) the University System of Maryland Administration;
- 4 (iv) the Department of Transportation;
- 5 (v) the Insurance Commissioner;
- 6 (vi) the State Comptroller;
- 7 (vii) the President of the Senate;
- 8 (viii) the Speaker of the House of Delegates;
- 9 (ix) the Maryland Classified Employees Association, Inc.;
- 10 (X) THE MARYLAND FEDERATION OF NURSES AND HEALTH
11 PROFESSIONALS;
- 12 (XI) THE MARYLAND PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES COUNCIL;
- 13 (XII) THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS LABOR ALLIANCE;
- 14 [(x)] (XIII) the Maryland Troopers Association; and
- 15 [(xi)] (XIV) the public; and
- 16 (3) three representatives of the American Federation of State, County,
17 and Municipal Employees, appointed by the Governor.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 1999.
