1 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 2 12-302. 3 (b) In the following jurisdictions the specified exceptions to subsection (a) of 4 this section apply: THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH APPLY ONLY IN 5 (8)(I) 6 GARRETT COUNTY.
