5 practice law under certain circumstances; and generally relating to orphans'
6 court judges in Howard County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Estates and Trusts**

15 2-109.

16 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a judge of the court
17 may not act as an attorney at law in a civil or criminal matter during a term of office.

18 (b) This section does not apply:

19 (1) In Harford County;

20 (2) In Montgomery County;

21 (3) In Baltimore City, to a judge of the Court while practicing law before
22 any court of the State except an orphans' court; or

23 (4) In Prince George's [and], Calvert, AND HOWARD Counties, to a judge
24 of the Court while practicing law in connection with a case that is:

- 1 (i) Outside the jurisdiction of orphans' court; and
- 2 (ii) Unrelated to the administration of an estate or guardianship.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
4 effect July 1, 1999.
