## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 **Hunting Licenses - Funds - Wildlife Habitat Improvement**

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to use certain
- funds to improve wildlife habitat in the State; authorizing the Department to 4
- 5 use certain funds for certain initiatives to improve wildlife habitat; authorizing
- 6 the Department to hire contractual employees to implement certain wildlife
- 7 habitat initiatives, to provide matching funds to certain landowners for wildlife
- 8 habitat development, and to enter into contracts to reimburse certain farmers
- 9 for planting and leaving unharvested grains, grasses, and legumes for a
- specified purpose; and generally relating to the use of funds from hunting 10
- licenses for wildlife habitat improvement. 11
- 12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 **Article - Natural Resources**
- 20 10-301.
- 21 [Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the] THE (1)(1)
- 22 Department shall use any funds generated by the increase in fees that are charged for
- 23 each hunting license for a nonresident under subsection (f)(5)(iv) and (v) and \$10.00 of
- 24 each fee charged under subsection (f)(5)(vii) of this section only [for the purpose of
- 25 feeding game birds and mammals] TO IMPROVE WILDLIFE HABITAT in the State.
- 26 [In fiscal year 1989, the Department shall use the funds under
- 27 paragraph (1) of this subsection for any purpose that the Department considers
- 28 appropriate.

- 1 (3) In fiscal year 1990 and in each subsequent fiscal year, the THE
- 2 Department [shall] MAY use the funds under paragraph (1) of this subsection only for
- 3 the purposes of [the feeding program] IMPROVING WILDLIFE HABITAT under
- 4 subsection (m) of this section.
- 5 (m) [The Department may enter into contracts with farmers in the State to
- 6 reimburse the farmer for planting and leaving grains, grasses, and legumes, including
- 7 clover, alfalfa, and soybeans, unharvested in the fields in order to be used to provide
- 8 feed for any game birds and mammals in the State.] THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE THE
- 9 FUNDS TO:
- 10 (1) HIRE CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEES TO IMPLEMENT WILDLIFE
- 11 HABITAT INITIATIVES PROVIDED THROUGH STATE AND FEDERAL CONSERVATION
- 12 PROGRAMS;
- 13 (2) PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS FOR WILDLIFE HABITAT DEVELOPMENT
- 14 TO LANDOWNERS IN THE STATE; OR
- 15 (3) ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH FARMERS IN THE STATE TO
- 16 REIMBURSE THE FARMER FOR PLANTING AND LEAVING UNHARVESTED GRAINS,
- 17 GRASSES, AND LEGUMES IN THE FIELDS TO PROVIDE FOOD OR COVER FOR
- 18 WILDLIFE.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 July 1, 1999.
