

- 1 (4) The Board may not renew an alcoholic beverages license until the 2 licensee has presented the Board with a certificate of receipt from the County Finance
- 3 Office that shows that there are not unpaid taxes on the merchandise, fixtures, and
- 4 stock of the applicant due to the County or State.

- 6 (c) (1) The Board of License Commissioners shall[:
- 7 (1) Collect the license fees; and
- 8 (2) Issue] ISSUE licenses for which provision is made in this article.

- 12 (x) In Wicomico County the Board of License Commissioners may impose a
