13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 18-501.

17 (a) There is a program of Delegate Scholarships in this State that are awarded
18 under this subtitle.

19 (b) A scholarship awarded under this subtitle may be used at:

20 (1) An eligible institution for a program of undergraduate, graduate, or
21 professional studies;

22 (2) An accredited undergraduate, graduate, or professional institution
23 outside the State, if:

24 (I) [the] THE applicant will be studying in an academic area that
25 is not available in this State; OR

26 (II) 1. THE APPLICANT IS DISABLED;
