A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Surplus Lines Insurance - Offers of Renewal**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that surplus lines insurance may not be procured on
4 certain residential property that is insured by an authorized insurer if the
5 authorized insurer has offered to renew the policy on substantially the same
6 terms and conditions; and generally relating to the procurement of surplus lines
7 insurance.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Insurance**

16 3-306.

17 (a) Surplus lines insurance may be procured from an unauthorized insurer if:

18 (1) for surplus lines insurance procured through a broker, the surplus
19 lines insurance is procured through a qualified surplus lines broker;

20 (2) subject to the provisions of § 3-306.1 of this subtitle, a diligent search
21 is made among the authorized insurers that are writing the particular kind and class
22 of insurance in the State;

23 (3) except for insurance against liability of persons described in §
24 24-206(1) of this article, the amount of surplus lines insurance procured from an
25 unauthorized insurer is only the excess over the amount that can be procured from
26 authorized insurers;

1 (4) for insurance against liability of persons described in § 24-206(1) of
2 this article, the insurance cannot be obtained from three or more authorized insurers
3 that are writing on a broad basis that particular kind and class of insurance;

4 (5) except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the surplus lines
5 insurance is not procured [solely to get]:

6 (i) SOLELY TO OBTAIN a lower premium rate than would be
7 accepted by an authorized insurer; [or]

8 (ii) SOLELY TO OBTAIN more favorable terms of the insurance
9 contract; [and] OR

10 (III) TO REPLACE COVERAGE ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY,
11 INCLUDING COVERAGE FOR CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATIONS, WHICH IS INSURED BY
12 AN AUTHORIZED INSURER AND FOR WHICH A RENEWAL OFFER HAS BEEN MADE ON
13 SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE CURRENT COVERAGE;
14 AND

15 (6) there is compliance with other applicable provisions of this subtitle.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 1999.
