- 20 (2) Of the materials penetrated in different localities.
- 21 (c) Before the Department adopts any rule or regulation that relates to the
- 22 construction of wells, the Department shall submit the proposed rule or regulation to
- 23 the Board for comment.
- 24 (d) Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, a county board of health,
- 25 delegated by the Department of the Environment to implement a well inspection
- 26 program, may collect a fee for the issuance of well permits required under § 9-1306 of

- 1 this subtitle. However, a county health department may not collect a fee for test or 2 irrigation wells. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTIONS (A) THROUGH (D) OF THIS (E) 4 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE THE 5 FOLLOWING TESTS OF WATER FROM A WELL USED FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES: HEAVY METALS; 6 (I) 7 VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS; AND (II)8 (III) CARCINOGENIC MATERIALS. 9 THE REGULATIONS SHALL APPLY TO ANY PERSON OR UNIT OF STATE (2) 10 OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT TESTS THE WATER FROM A WELL.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 1999.
