HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Taylor/West Gateway Circle - Unity Circle - Annapolis**

3 FOR the purpose of supporting the designation of Taylor/West Gateway Circle,
4 Annapolis as "Unity Circle".

5 WHEREAS, On November 4, 1996, the Annapolis City Council adopted
6 resolutions that authorized the construction of the Taylor/West Gateway Circle
7 Project; and

8 WHEREAS, The State of Maryland embraces all of its citizens, regardless of
9 race, religion, ethnic heritage, or gender; and

10 WHEREAS, The State of Maryland wishes to underscore the message of
11 tolerance for all people and to teach children the importance of unity and peace
12 among all people; and

13 WHEREAS, The naming of Taylor/West Gateway Circle, Annapolis, as "Unity
14 Circle" appropriately recognizes the unity, harmony, and tolerance demonstrated by
15 the citizens of Annapolis; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the State
17 of Maryland strongly supports the designation of Taylor/West Gateway Circle in
18 Annapolis as "Unity Circle"; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
20 Legislative Services to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland;
21 the Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; the
22 Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates; the Honorable
23 Dean Johnson, Mayor, City of Annapolis; and the members of the Annapolis City
24 Council.
