## 2 False Statements to Legislative Branch Units

- 3 FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor for a person, in a matter within the
- 4 jurisdiction of a unit of the Legislative Branch of the State government, to
- 5 knowingly and willfully falsify or conceal a material fact, make a false, fictitious,
- 6 or fraudulent representation, or make or use a document that contains a false,
- 7 fictitious, or fraudulent representation; making this Act applicable only to
- 8 certain recorded hearings and proceedings; imposing a penalty for this offense;
- 9 defining a certain term; and generally relating to false statements to Legislative
- 10 Branch units.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "UNIT" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OF
- 21 THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT:
- 22 (1) A STANDING COMMITTEE AS DEFINED IN § 2-101(F) OF THIS TITLE
- 23 OR A SUBCOMMITTEE OF A STANDING COMMITTEE:
- 24 (2) A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY STATUTE OR A
- 25 SUBCOMMITTEE OF A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE;

- 1 (3) THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR A SPECIAL COMMITTEE 2 APPOINTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE UNDER § 2-407(B)(3) OF THIS 3 TITLE; OR
- 4 (4) ANY OTHER TASK FORCE OR COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE 5 LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE HOUSE OR 6 SENATE.
- 7 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO HEARINGS OR OTHER PROCEEDINGS OF A 8 UNIT THAT ARE REQUIRED TO BE RECORDED BY THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OR 9 SENATE.
- 10 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT, IN A MATTER WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF A UNIT, 11 KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY:
- 12 (1) FALSIFY OR CONCEAL A MATERIAL FACT;
- 13 (2) MAKE A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION; OR
- 14 (3) MAKE OR USE A DOCUMENT THAT CONTAINS A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, 15 OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION.
- 16 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 17 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000,
- 18 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR, OR BOTH.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 1999.
