A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Courts - District Court Facilities in Baltimore County**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain termination date for the requirement that a
4 District Court facility be located in the Dundalk area of Baltimore County; and
5 generally relating to the availability of the services of the District Court of
6 Maryland in District 8.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

20 1-603.

21 (d) To assure that the services of the District Court are readily and practicably
22 available in all areas of District 8, subject to the time [limits] LIMIT contained in
23 ITEM (5) OF this subsection, and to assure that these services are provided to all
24 citizens of District 8 with a minimum of inconvenience and a maximum of availability,
25 there shall be a court facility physically located in each of the following areas of that
26 district, and at least one judge shall sit regularly in each location:

27 (1) The Towson area;

- 1 (2) The Catonsville area;
- 2 (3) The Dundalk area [until June 30, 1999];
- 3 (4) The Essex area; and
- 4 (5) The Owings Mills area until June 30, 1999.

5 **Chapter 320 of the Acts of 1993, as amended by Chapter 566 of the Acts of**
6 **1996 and Chapter 14 of the Acts of 1997**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, Notwithstanding the
8 provisions of any other law, including Section 1(3), Item 23.05.02(F) of Chapter 4 of
9 the Laws of Maryland, First Extraordinary Session, 1992 and Section 2, of Chapter
10 421 of the Laws of Maryland, 1990, it is the intent of the General Assembly that
11 District Court facilities be located [in] IN: (1) the Dundalk area of Baltimore County
12 [until June 30, 1999 and]; AND (2) THE Owings Mills area of Baltimore County until
13 June 30, 1999.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 June 1, 1999.
