1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State-Owned Airports - Motor Vehicle Parking and Other Regulations -**
3 **Penalties for Violations**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum fine for violations of certain regulations
5 governing motor vehicle parking at State-owned airports; increasing the
6 maximum fine for violations of certain other vehicle and safety related
7 regulations occurring at State-owned airports; making a stylistic change; and
8 generally relating to penalties for certain violations at State-owned airports.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

2 5-426.

3 (a) After holding a public hearing, the governing body of any publicly owned
4 airport in this State may adopt regulations for:

5 (1) The parking of motor vehicles at the airport, including provision of a
6 uniform system for accessible parking for individuals with disabilities to enhance the
7 safety of people with disabilities in conformity with:

8 (i) The "Uniform System for Parking for Persons With Disabilities"
9 (23 CFR Part 1235);

10 (ii) The "Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines
11 for Buildings and Facilities" (Appendix A to 28 CFR Part 36 and 36 CFR Part 1191.1);
12 and

13 (iii) 14 CFR Part 382.23(a);

14 (2) The movement of traffic at the airport;

15 (3) Safety at the airport; and

16 (4) The preservation of order at the airport.

17 (b) All regulations adopted under this section shall be posted conspicuously in
18 a public place at the airport.

20 (a) (1) [Any] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
21 SUBSECTION, A person who violates a parking regulation adopted and posted under §
22 5-426 of this subtitle is subject to a fine not exceeding \$50.

23 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PARKING REGULATION ADOPTED AND
24 POSTED UNDER § 5-426 OF THIS SUBTITLE AT A STATE-OWNED AIRPORT IS SUBJECT
25 TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100.

26 (3) A violation of a parking regulation is not a misdemeanor.

27 (b)(1) [Any] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
28 person who violates any [other rule or] regulation adopted and posted under § 5-426
29 of this subtitle OTHER THAN A PARKING REGULATION is guilty of a misdemeanor and
30 on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.

31 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY REGULATION ADOPTED AND POSTED
32 UNDER § 5-426 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OTHER THAN A PARKING REGULATION, AT A
33 STATE-OWNED AIRPORT IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS
34 SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 1999.
