- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 13 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 15 (c) Nothing in this section shall prevent the wearing, carrying, or
- 16 transporting of a handgun by: (i) law-enforcement personnel of the United States, or
- 17 of this State, or of any county or city of this State; (ii) members of the armed forces of
- 18 the United States or of the National Guard while on duty or traveling to or from duty;
- 19 (iii) law-enforcement personnel of some other state or subdivision thereof temporarily
- 20 in this State on official business; (iv) any jailer, prison guard, warden, or guard or
- 21 keeper at any penal, correctional or detention institution in this State; [or] (v)

- 1 sheriffs [and temporary or full-time] OF THIS STATE OR FULL-TIME ASSISTANT OR
- 2 DEPUTY SHERIFFS OF THIS STATE; OR (VI) TEMPORARY OR PART-TIME sheriffs'
- 3 deputies, as to all of whom this exception shall apply only when they are on active
- 4 assignment engaged in law enforcement; provided, that any such person mentioned in
- 5 this paragraph is duly authorized at the time and under the circumstances he is
- 6 wearing, carrying, or transporting the weapon to wear, carry, or transport such
- 7 weapon as part of his official equipment.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 9 effect October 1, 1999.
