- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) On receipt of a copy of an earnings withholding order an employer shall,
- 17 beginning with the next pay period after receipt of the order:
- 18 (1) deduct the amount of the withholding from the obligor's earnings on
- 19 a regular basis; and
- 20 (2) send the deducted net amount directly to the support enforcement
- 21 agency or the recipient, as specified in the order, within [10] 7 days NOT INCLUDING
- 22 SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR A LEGAL HOLIDAY after the day on which the earnings are
- 23 paid to the obligor.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 25 effect July 1, 1999.
