- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the time period within which an employer is required to
- 4 send certain support payments that are deducted from the earnings of an

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 16 (a) On receipt of a copy of an earnings withholding order an employer shall,
- 17 beginning with the next pay period after receipt of the order:
- 18 (1) deduct the amount of the withholding from the obligor's earnings on
- 19 a regular basis; and

- 1 (2) send the deducted net amount directly to the support enforcement 2 agency or the recipient, as specified in the order, within [10] 7 days NOT INCLUDING 3 SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR A LEGAL HOLIDAY after the day on which the earnings are

- 4 paid to the obligor.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 6 effect July 1, 1999.
