A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Home Improvement Commission - Temporary Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the authority of the Maryland Home Improvement
4 Commission to issue certain temporary licenses; and generally relating to
5 licensing by the Commission.

7 Article - Business Regulation
8 Section 8-304

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Business Regulation**

14 [8-304.

15 (a) In accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission, the executive
16 director may issue a temporary license to an applicant who submits to the
17 Commission:

18 (1) a proper application for a license; and

19 (2) each required fee.

20 (b) (1) A temporary contractor license authorizes the holder to act as a
21 contractor or subcontractor and to sell a home improvement.

22 (2) A temporary subcontractor license authorizes the holder to act as a
23 subcontractor.

1 (3) A temporary salesperson license authorizes the holder to sell a home
2 improvement.

3 (c) A temporary license:

4 (1) may be terminated by the executive director before the Commission
5 issues or denies a license to the applicant; and

6 (2) expires when the Commission issues or denies a license to the
7 applicant.]

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 1999.
