- 15 (a) In accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission, the executive
- 16 director may issue a temporary license to an applicant who submits to the
- 17 Commission:
- 18 (1) a proper application for a license; and
- 19 (2) each required fee.

## **SENATE BILL 51**

- 1 (b) (1) A temporary contractor license authorizes the holder to act as a 2 contractor or subcontractor and to sell a home improvement. A temporary subcontractor license authorizes the holder to act as a (2) 4 subcontractor. 5 A temporary salesperson license authorizes the holder to sell a home 6 improvement. 7 (c) A temporary license: 8 may be terminated by the executive director before the Commission (1) 9 issues or denies a license to the applicant; and 10 (2) expires when the Commission issues or denies a license to the 11 applicant.]
