- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain application, testing, retesting, and renewal fees
- 4 for tree expert licenses; altering the requirements for reexamination of certain
- 5 applications; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to tree
- 6 experts.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article - Natural Resources

- 20 5-415.
- 21 (a) In this part, the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 22 (b) "Licensed tree expert" means a person who has received from the
- 23 Department a license displaying his qualifications to practice as a tree expert.
- 24 (c) "Tree expert" means a person who holds himself out as being skilled in the
- 25 science of tree care and who, whether in [his own] THE business OF THE PERSON or

- 1 as the employee of another person and whether under the title of arborist, tree
- 2 specialist, tree surgeon, tree expert, or otherwise, engages in the business or work of
- 3 the treatment and care of trees for compensation by making diagnoses, prescribing,
- 4 and supervising the treatment for trees.
- 5 5-416.
- The Department may examine applicants for licensing as tree experts and pass pupon their competence.
- 8 5-417.
- A person may not engage in the work or business of a tree expert without a
- 10 license issued under the provisions of this part. An employee[,] under the supervision
- 11 of a licensed tree expert may not be required to have a license in [his own] THE name
- 12 OF THE EMPLOYEE.
- 13 5-418.
- 14 (a) The Department may examine an applicant for license as a tree expert and
- 15 pass upon [his] THE competence OF THE APPLICANT. [It] THE DEPARTMENT shall
- 16 issue a "tree expert" license to any applicant, who: (1) pays the fee provided in §
- 17 5-419; (2) [has attained his eighteenth birthday] IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE; (3)
- 18 (i) has had 2 years of approved college education in forestry, arboriculture,
- 19 horticulture, applied agricultural sciences, or the equivalent education and a
- 20 minimum of 1 year of experience with a licensed tree expert in Maryland or with an
- 21 acceptable tree expert company in another state; or (ii) for at least 5 years
- 22 immediately preceding the date of [his] application has been engaged continuously in
- 23 practice as a tree expert with a licensed tree expert in Maryland or with an acceptable
- 24 tree expert company in another state; and (4) has passed the examination given by
- 25 the Department.
- 26 (b) Every licensee shall carry and show proof of liability and property damage
- 27 insurance, in the form and amount required by the Department at the time it issues
- 28 the license. The licensee shall maintain the insurance protection for the period the
- 29 license is in effect.
- 30 5-419.
- 31 (a) An applicant shall pay to the Department at the time of making [his] AN
- 32 application[,] a fee of [\$30] \$50. An applicant who fails any examination[,] shall pay
- 33 an additional fee of [\$20] \$30 for each subsequent examination [he] THE APPLICANT
- 34 takes.
- 35 (b) A tree expert license shall be renewed annually. A person who holds a
- 36 license and wishes to renew it shall pay a [\$10] \$30 annual renewal fee.
- 37 (c) Fees the Department receives shall be paid into the State treasury for the
- 38 Department's use. The Secretary shall prepare an annual report on the number of

- 1 licenses issued and the receipts and expenses under Part III of this subtitle during
- 2 each fiscal year.
- 3 5-420.
- 4 The Department shall prepare and conduct examinations as often as necessary,
- 5 but at least once a year if there are any applicants. A candidate who has [passed]
- 6 FAILED ANY SUBJECT, WHICH IS PART OF the examination [in all but one of the
- 7 subjects] given may be reexamined in that subject only at any subsequent
- 8 examination held, and if [he] THE CANDIDATE passes that subject [he] THE
- 9 CANDIDATE is considered to have passed the examination. The Department, however,
- 10 may decide to reexamine an unsuccessful candidate in every subject.
- 11 5-421.
- 12 (a) The Department may permanently revoke or temporarily suspend the
- 13 license of any licensed tree expert who is found guilty of any fraud or deceit in
- 14 obtaining the license, or guilty of negligence or wrongful conduct in the practice of
- 15 tree culture or care.
- 16 (b) The Department may promulgate rules of ethics and temporarily suspend
- 17 for a period not to exceed two years the license of any licensed tree expert who violates
- 18 the rules of ethics. This power of suspension is in addition to, and not in limitation of,
- 19 the power to revoke or suspend provided in subsection (a).
- 20 (c) A license issued under this subtitle may not be revoked or suspended until
- 21 after the licensee has a hearing before the Department. Notice of the cause for
- 22 suspension or revocation and the hearing date shall be sent to the licensee at [his]
- 23 THE last known address OF THE LICENSEE by registered or certified mail at least 20
- 24 days before the hearing. The nonappearance of the licensee after the required notice
- 25 has been given, does not prevent holding the hearing.
- 26 (d) The Department may reissue any tree expert's license previously revoked
- 27 under rules and regulations it prescribes.
- 28 5-422.
- 29 The Department may issue and grant a license to or otherwise authorize the
- 30 practice as a tree expert in Maryland by any person who is a lawful holder of a tree
- 31 expert license under the laws of another state which extends similar privileges to
- 32 licensed tree experts of this State. The requirements for the license in the state which
- 33 has granted it must be, in the opinion of the Department, at least equivalent to those
- 34 provided for in Maryland.
- 35 5-423.
- 36 (a) A person may not: (1) solicit, advertise, or represent [himself] to the public
- 37 THAT THE PERSON [as] IS a tree expert, or assume to practice as a tree expert
- 38 without having received a license; or (2) after having received the license and
- 39 subsequently losing it by revocation or suspension continue to practice as a tree

- 1 expert, or; (3) use the title or abbreviation "L.T.E." or any other words, letters, or 2 abbreviations tending to indicate that [he] THE PERSON is a licensed tree expert or a
- 3 tree expert without having received a license, or when the license has been revoked or
- 4 suspended.
- 5 (b) If the owner of a tree employs any person to trim the tree, the owner is not 6 subject to this penalty.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 effect October 1, 1999.
