- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (E) (1) THE DIRECTOR MAY ESTABLISH A PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE
- 19 PROGRAM FOR SALES EMPLOYEES CLASSIFIED AS LOTTERY REPRESENTATIVES AND
- 20 LOTTERY REGIONAL MANAGERS.
- 21 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES UNDER
- 22 THIS SUBSECTION, EMPLOYEES MUST MEET OR EXCEED MEASURABLE
- 23 PERFORMANCE LEVELS AS ESTABLISHED BY THE DIRECTOR.
- 24 (3) PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 25 MAY BE PAID ONLY FROM THE AGENCY'S APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR AS
- 26 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

- 1 (4) PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES MAY NOT BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS
- 2 SUBSECTION IF THE AGENCY DOES NOT ACHIEVE ITS SALES ESTIMATES AS
- 3 PRESENTED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 5 effect July 1, 1999.
