A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Lottery Agency - Performance Incentive Program**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the State Lottery Agency to establish
4 a performance incentive program for certain employees of the State Lottery
5 Agency under certain circumstances; providing for the funding of performance
6 incentives; prohibiting the use of performance incentives under certain
7 circumstances; and generally relating to the operation of the State Lottery
8 Agency.

11 Section 9-111(e)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1998 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - State Government**

17 9-111.

18 (E) (1) THE DIRECTOR MAY ESTABLISH A PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE
19 PROGRAM FOR SALES EMPLOYEES CLASSIFIED AS LOTTERY REPRESENTATIVES AND
20 LOTTERY REGIONAL MANAGERS.

21 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES UNDER
22 THIS SUBSECTION, EMPLOYEES MUST MEET OR EXCEED MEASURABLE
23 PERFORMANCE LEVELS AS ESTABLISHED BY THE DIRECTOR.

24 (3) PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
25 MAY BE PAID ONLY FROM THE AGENCY'S APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR AS
26 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

1 (4) PERFORMANCE INCENTIVES MAY NOT BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS
2 SUBSECTION IF THE AGENCY DOES NOT ACHIEVE ITS SALES ESTIMATES AS
3 PRESENTED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
5 effect July 1, 1999.
