	(a) [If] ACCORDING TO THE NATURE AND FREQUENCY OF THE VIOLATION, IF an inmate violates the applicable rules of discipline, the Division may revoke a portion or all of the diminution credits awarded:
20 21	(1) under §§ 3-704 (good conduct) and 3-707 (special projects) of this subtitle [according to the nature and frequency of the violation]; AND
24	(2) UNDER §§ 11-503 (PRESENTENCE GOOD CONDUCT), 11-504 (POSTSENTENCE GOOD CONDUCT), AND 11-506 (SPECIAL SELECTED WORK PROJECTS) OF THIS ARTICLE WHILE THE INMATE WAS CONFINED IN A LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
