16 (a) In this section, "highway work zone" means a construction or maintenance 17 area on or alongside a highway that is marked by appropriate warning signs or other 18 traffic control devices designating that work is in progress.

19 (b) (1) The State Highway Administration may reduce established speed 20 limits in a highway work zone upon a determination that the change is necessary to 21 ensure the public safety.

- 22 (2) A COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY MAY:
- 23 (I) DESIGNATE AN AREA AS A HIGHWAY WORK ZONE;

24 (II) REDUCE ESTABLISHED SPEED LIMITS IN A HIGHWAY WORK
25 ZONE AFTER A DETERMINATION THAT THE CHANGE IS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE
