- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

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- 3 (1) (1) To provide for competitive bidding for any county work and the
- 4 making and awarding of contracts for the purchase of materials and supplies in
- 5 excess of \$15,000 and to require bonds in connection with the work or contracts,
- 6 regardless of the amount, whenever the County Commissioners consider it proper to
- 7 require a bond; and if no bids are submitted in response to any request for bids, to
- 8 place the order in a manner that the County Commissioners consider appropriate.
- 9 (II) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, TO PROVIDE FOR COMPETITIVE
- 10 BIDDING FOR ANY COUNTY WORK AND THE MAKING AND AWARDING OF CONTRACTS
- 11 FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES IN EXCESS OF \$50,000 \$30,000 AND
- 12 TO REQUIRE BONDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE WORK OR CONTRACTS, REGARDLESS
- 13 OF THE AMOUNT, WHENEVER THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER IT PROPER
- 14 TO REQUIRE A BOND; AND IF NO BIDS ARE SUBMITTED IN RESPONSE TO ANY
- 15 REQUEST FOR BIDS, TO PLACE THE ORDER IN A MANNER THAT THE COUNTY
- 16 COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.
- 17 (2) The provisions of paragraph (1)(I) of this subsection are not
- 18 applicable in Somerset County with regard solely to contracting for the services of an
- 19 architectural and/or engineering firm for design and/or consultation purposes. With
- 20 regard to contracting for other county work these provisions are applicable.
- 21 (3) The provisions of paragraph (1)(II) of this subsection are not
- 22 applicable in Frederick County with regard solely to contracting for the services of an
- 23 architectural, engineering, or consultant firm for design or consultation purposes. In
- 24 Frederick County, contracts for architectural and engineering services costing more
- 25 than \$15,000 \$30,000, shall be awarded on a competitive basis which shall consist of
- 26 either sealed competitive bids or competitive negotiation. "Competitive negotiation"
- 27 means a process that includes the submission of written technical and price proposals
- 28 from two or more sources and a written evaluation of those proposals in accordance
- 29 with evaluation criteria.
- 30 (4) The provisions of paragraph (1)(I) of this subsection are not
- 31 applicable in Charles County with regard to contracting for any professional services.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 July 1, 1999.
